

# *Self-made hybrid 3 layer mask*

# ***1. Choose your Fabric***



Polyester as a the outer layer

Soft cotton 2 layers as the inner layer

## *2. Aline them together, keep polyester layer upper side*



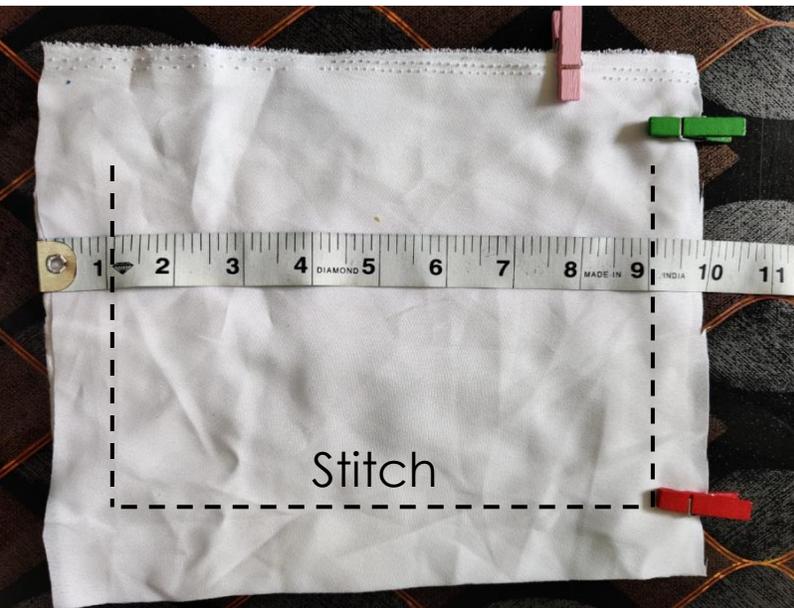
Test and make sure you can breath through the layers

### ***3. Cut 10 cm wide and 8 cm in height***

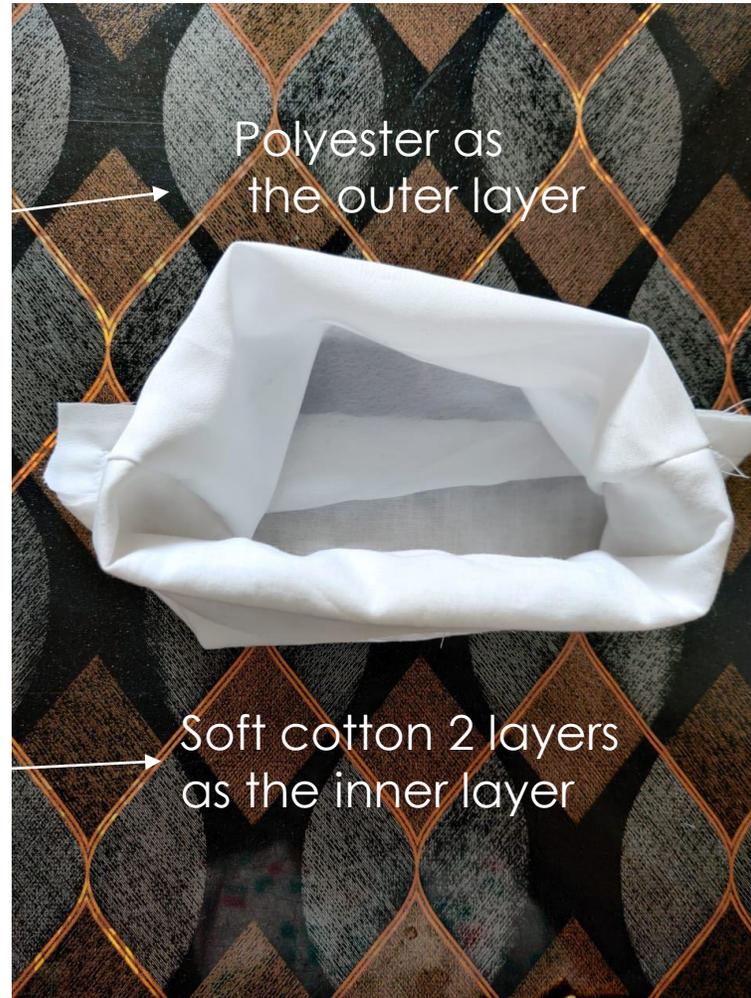


8 x10 inches

## ***4. Stitch or sew 3 sides***



# *5. Inside out such that you get polyester side on upper side*



## ***6. Stitch the unstitched side***

Fold 1 of the edge inside



Fold the second edge inside



Hold together with clamps or pins  
If required

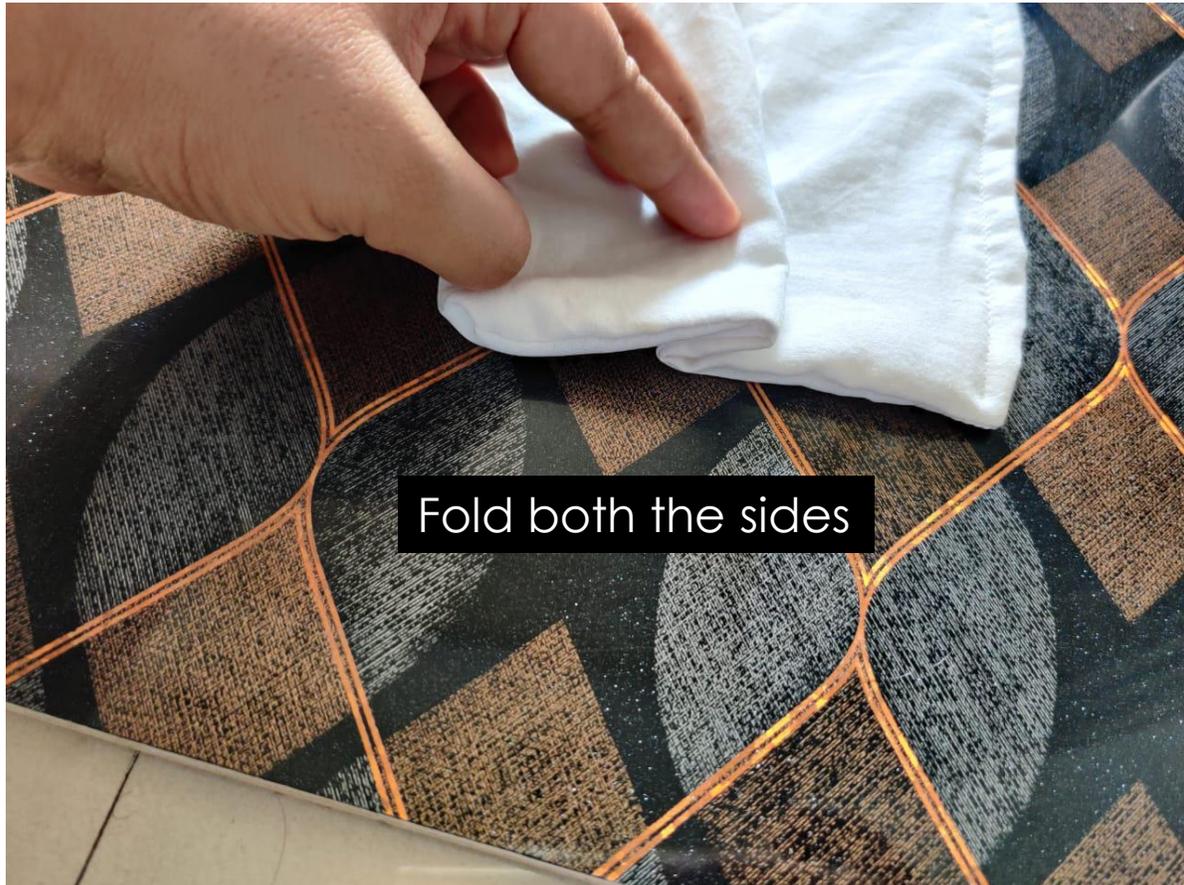


All side stitched

## ***7. Fold about an inch in the middle of the mask***



## *7. Fold about an inch in the middle of the mask*



Fold both the sides

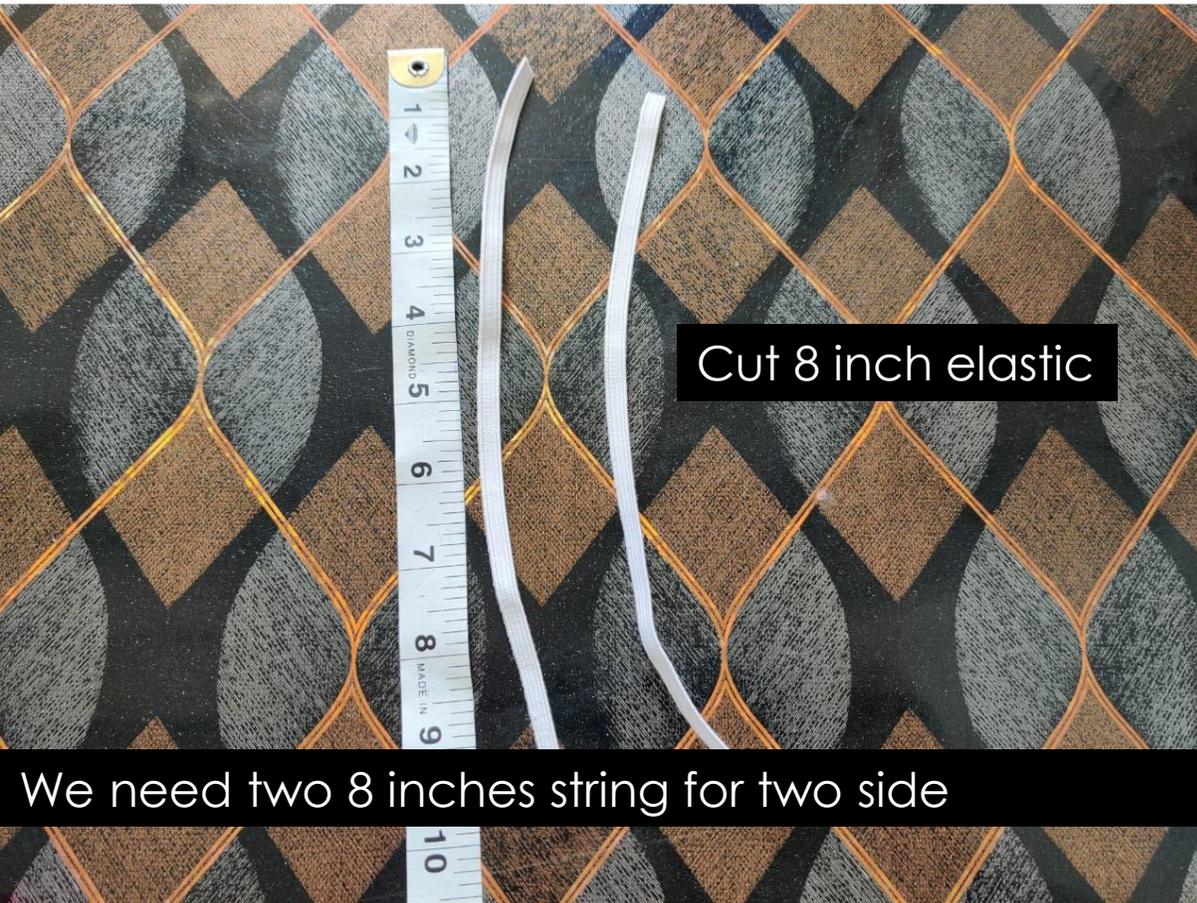


Use clamps or pins if required and  
stitch on dotted lines

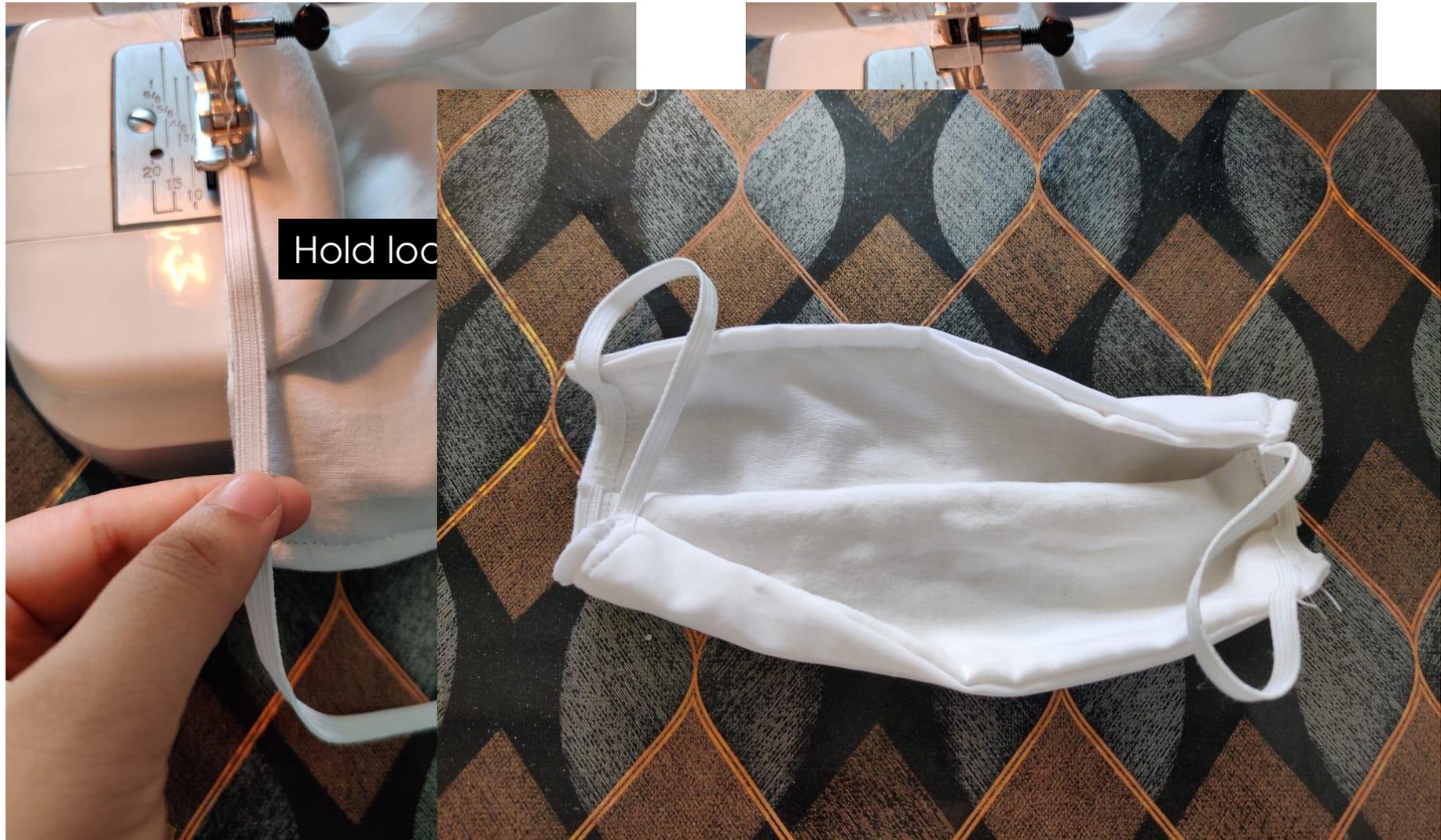
## *8. Stitch both sides of mask*



## *9. Add Elastic*



# *10. Start stitching the corner*



## ***11. Stitch the end of the elastic back to the corner where it started***



## *12. Adjust the elastic and wear the mask*



Full coverage mask

## ***13. Important points***

- Shorten the elastic if the mask is too loose

It should fit tightly

- Deep in hot soap water or 1% diluted bleach solution for one minute to disinfect after single use
- Reuse after drying
